

Learning Outcomes: ARTS 311 – Black & White Photography

Level 1 – Knowledge

- Identify and know the use of all the chemistry used in traditional photography (developers, stop baths, fixers, etc.)
- Identify and know all the parts of the camera (shutter types, aperture, film types, etc.)
- Explain the different camera types and their uses.
- Explore the elements of visual design and their use in photography.
