

## Learning Outcomes: VIST 106 – Principles of Design II

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### **Level 1 – Knowledge**

- Identify and demonstrate the vocabulary and techniques pertinent to working with a variety of three-dimensional media.

### **Level 2 - Comprehension**

- Describe the relationship between viewpoint, perspective, space and form.

### **Level 3 - Application**

- Solve problems with the emphasis particularly on physical space, form and design within the parameters imposed by those dimensions.
- Use principles of reduction and abstraction in sculptural form.

### **Level 4 - Analysis**

- Distinguish aspects of craft insofar as they interface and overlap with art.
- Differentiate between 2 and 3 dimensions; how information is passed from one to the other.

### **Level 5 - Synthesis**

- Demonstrate skills in the construction and realization of compelling forms.
- Design using aspects of light in the context of 3-Dimensional design.
- Design using aspects of color in the context of 3-Dimensional form.

### **Level 6 - Evaluation**

- Analyze, evaluate and apply criticism as a means to develop creative works and personal expression.
